

# Welcome to Belvidere Township Park

## Camping Rules

Reservations may be made in person or by phone to Park Manager (989) 365-3555

Camping will be available from the first Friday of May till the end of October.

*A nonrefundable \$30.00/ \$35.00 rent will be required.* If occupation does not occur within 24 hours with no prior notification, any fees paid will not be refunded. The lot will then be considered vacant and available. Any lot occupied will be considered rented.

- 50amp lots Nightly Rate \$35.00. Monthly rate \$800.00
- **Lots 21 thru 26 only**, 30amp lots, Nightly Rate \$30.  
Monthly rate \$650.00.

Check in time is after 1:00 p.m. Check out time is 11:00 a.m. Maximum stay on a lot is 30 consecutive days. One family per campsite, maximum of 8 persons.

When using shower, children should be accompanied by a responsible adult. Activities should be confined to your campsite. **Fireworks, motorbikes, skateboards, or skates are prohibited in the park.** Loud music, profanity, or noise disturbance will not be tolerated. Defacing any wall/structure, carving/marring of tables/benches, or damaging playground equipment shall be considered malicious destruction of Township property and may be punishable by law. Campfires are permitted only in the fire ring on your campsite. Quiet time in the park is 10:00 p.m.

Roadways in the Park shall be clear of any vehicles. Park camping vehicle parallel to campsite side lot boundaries. Camping units shall be 10 feet or greater from one another. Bicycles may be ridden in the roadways. No bikes in Pavilions or the swimming/beach area. Over flow parking and visitor parking is available.

A fish cleaning station is provided. Please dispose of discarded cleanings in the receptacles adjacent to the station. Fish cleaning is not permitted on any campsite. Gray water shall be contained, not released on the ground. Campers are responsible for gray and black water. A dump station is provided for use by campers.

## **Pavilions, Playground, and Beach/Swimming/Area Rules**

Should you want to reserve the Pavilion you may do so by contacting the Park Manager at (989) 365-3555. A fee of \$50.00 will be charged, the pavilion can be reserved from 8:00a.m. to 10:00 p.m. When pavilion is reserved, a sign will be posted, it is not open to others at that time.

There shall be no glass containers on the playground, swimming/beach or pavilions. The pavilions, playground, and swimming beach area close at 10:00 p.m.

### **Animals in the Park**

Pets are not permitted on the playground, swimming/beach area, pavilions, or the shower/bathroom buildings. Pets are permitted in the park and are to be confined to your campsite. Pets shall be leashed when outside their owner's camping unit. Pets shall be attended at all times. Food and water dishes shall be taken inside at night. All animal feces are the responsibility of the animal's owner. Feces shall be properly disposed of immediately. Pets shall remain south of the north roadway of the park. Destruction of Park property (digging of holes, etc.) shall be the pet owner's responsibility to fill or replace. Pets are limited to **two** per campsite. Barking or aggressive behavior by pets will not be tolerated and can result in eviction.

**Horses** are not permitted in the campground, playground, swimming/beach area, pavilions, or shower/bathroom area. Horse feces will be cleaned up by owner.

### **Noncampers/Visitors**

Noncampers may use all facilities except bath house. Charge of \$10.00 will apply to non-campers for using dump station. Parking is available in the front parking lot for non-campers.

**Any camper found not to be following the rules of Park, Pavilion, etc. may be evicted from the campground. If you are asked to leave there will be no refund on camp rentals.**
